

How To: Install Shrouds with Centric Rings

Tools & Materials Required:

- Silicone Glue (DAP Silicone II Glue recommended)

Products used: Morimoto Shroud Centric Rings, Assorted Shrouds



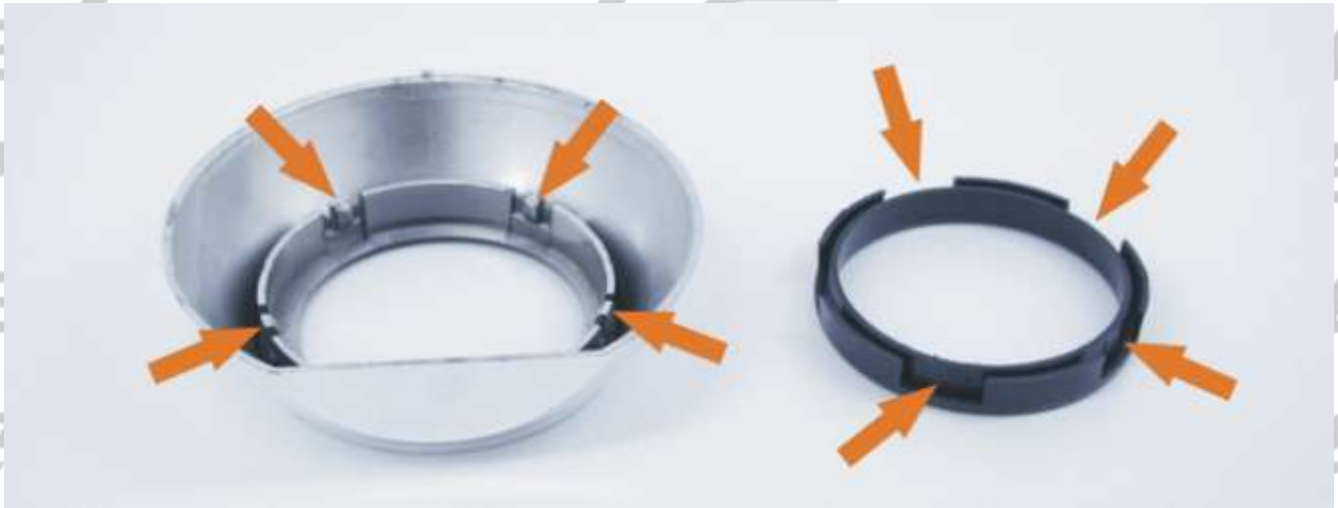
Disclaimer: This How To covers the three types of installs the centric rings are used for:

- 1) Standard Install
- 2) Gatling Gun - Reversed
- 3) Gatling Gun 2 / Mini Graphite - Compression

Standard Install

This type of install is applicable to the following shrouds: Apollo, E46-R, E46-R Extended, E55-R, Iris, GTi-R, MC-R, Ocular, and Orbit.

To install, begin by aligning the five “clips” on the back of the shroud with the five cut outs on the centric rings, like below. The clips affix to the recessed areas in the outside of the centric rings.



Then, to install the ring into the shroud by pressing firmly with both thumbs until the centric ring “clicks” into all five clips on the shroud.

The shroud and ring combination then presses onto the projector and then may require silicone glue to retain adhesion with the projector. We recommend DAP Silicone II glue.



Full size Gatling Gun

This installation is called “reversed” because instead of the five notches in the centric ring aligning to face out the back of the projector, they help to “clamp” onto the back of the shroud and face forward to the front of the projector.

To install, simply press the centric ring onto the backside of the shroud’s inner flex plates using a moderate amount of pressure. You may need to finagle them into place. Some glue is recommended in between the flex plates and the inside surface of the centric ring.



Mini Graphite and Gatling Gun 2.0

This installation is called “compression” because it uses pressure required during installation to maintain strength between the centric ring and shroud.

To install, press the centric rings in the shroud until they cannot be pressed further using only your thumbs.

Disclaimer: When installed in the Graphite shroud, the centric rings do not press all the way flush with the 'face' or front of the shroud.
